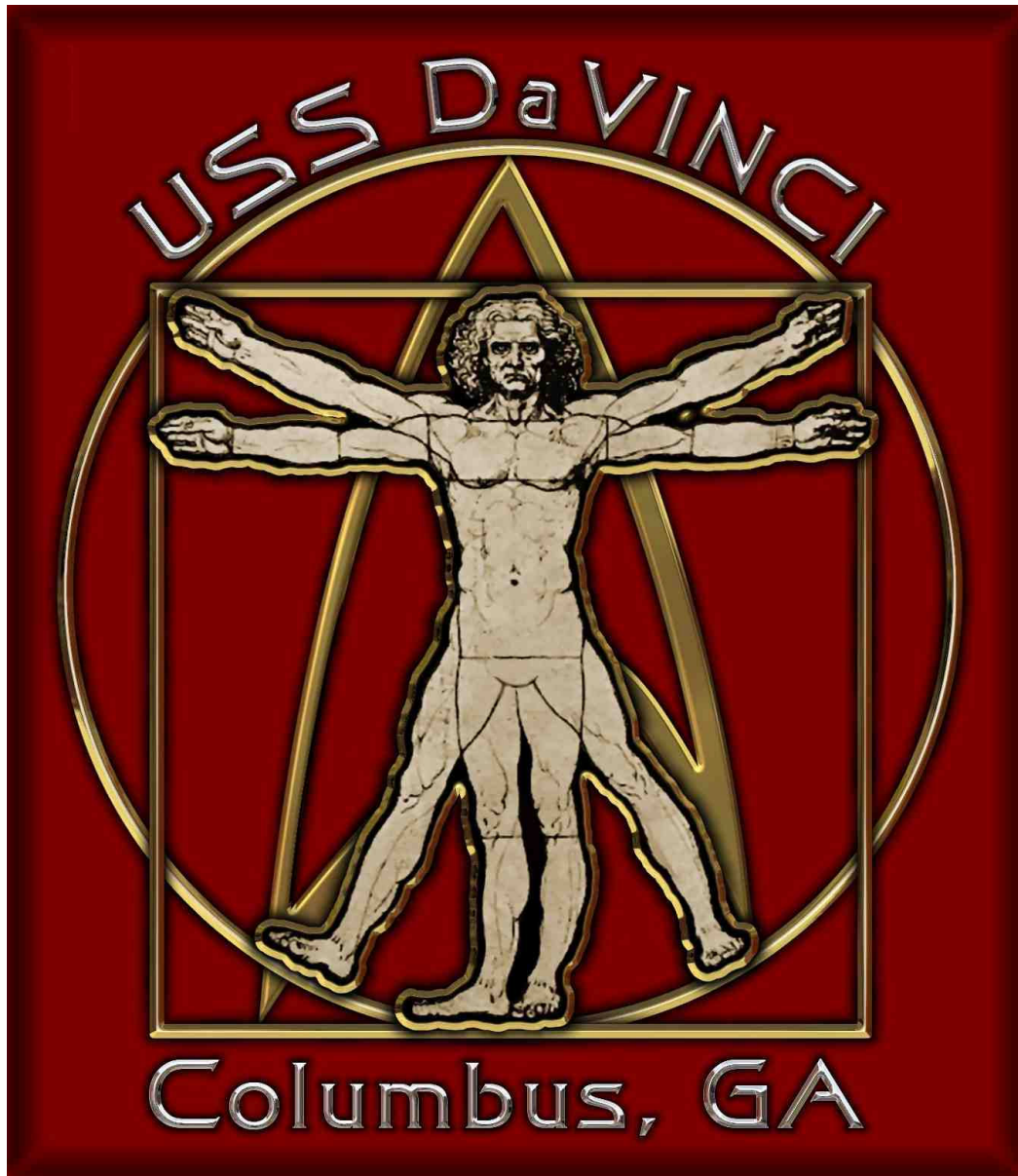

IT'S THE CAPTAIN CALLING

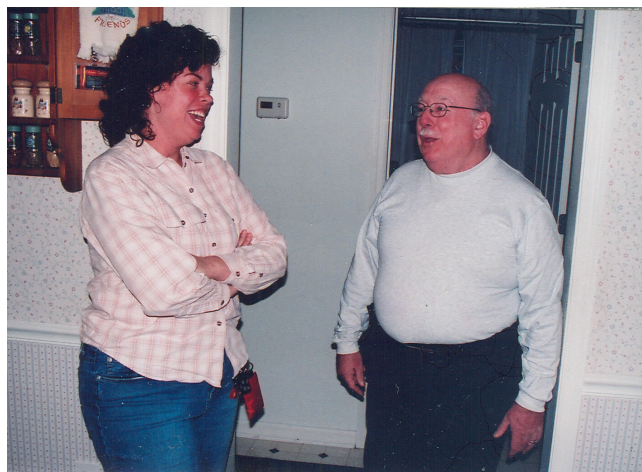

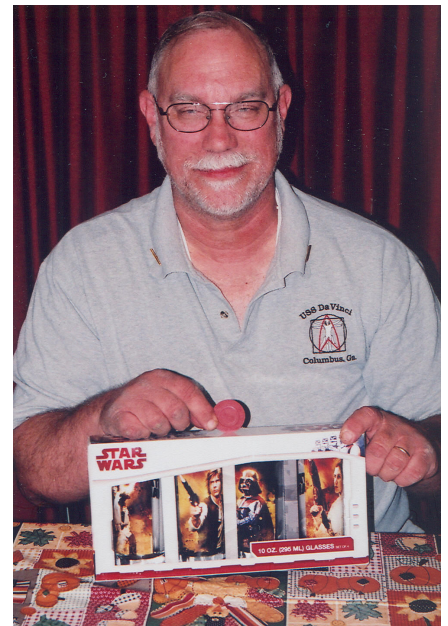
