

## REPLIMAT RECIPES

It's February. That means Valentine's Day is looming. The holiday of hearts typically means doing something special for the romantic interest in your life. So let's channel our inner Klingon and bake up some rokeg blood pie to show our love ones how much we care.

I've got two recipes for you this month. One is a "blood" pie suitable for anyone. The other is a bit more...traditional. We'll start with the easier recipe.

### **Rokeg Blood Pie**

#### **Ingredients**

½ lb butternut squash, cubed

4 red beets, cubed

½ onion, cubed

5 button mushroom heads, coarsely chopped

3-4 tbsp olive oil

1 ½ tsp ground sage

1 tsp garlic powder

1 tsp fresh parsley, chopped

½ tsp salt

½ tsp pepper

½ lb sausage

½ lb bacon

1 whole wheat pie crust

1 baking potato

1 egg

#### **Directions**

- 1. Preheat oven to 400F.
- 2. Place beets, squash, onion, and mushrooms on baking sheet. Coat them with olive oil, 1 tsp sage, ½ tsp garlic powder, ¼ tsp pepper, ½ tsp salt, and the parsley. Toss to combine so veggies are evenly coated. Place them in oven. Pierce potato several times with a fork and place it on oven rack next to the baking sheet. Roast 30 minutes, making sure to stir the veggies about every ten minutes.
- 3. While veggies roast, fry up the bacon and transfer to paper towel to drain. Leave the bacon grease in the pan. Remove sausages from their casings and fry them in the bacon grease, chopping them up as they cook. When fully browned, place the sausage on a paper towel to drain.
- 4. When veggies are fork tender, remove from oven. Turn down oven to 375F (or whatever temperature your pie crust calls for).
- 5. carefully remove the skin from the potato and place it in a large bowl with ½ tsp sage, ½ tsp garlic powder, salt and pepper to taste, and the egg. Which until smooth. Add 2/3 each of the bacon, sausage, and vegetables. Stir until fully mixed. Set bowl aside, and reserve remaining meat and veggies for later.

- 6. Roll out your pie crust to about 14 inches and gently lower into a greased 9-inch pie tin. Trim excess dough form edge and decorate if desired. (Skip this step if you're using store-bought pie crust that comes in a tin already.)
- 7. Thoroughly pierce bottom of crust with fork in several places. Pre-bake for 15 minutes.
- 8. Pour potato mixture into pie crust. Spread reserved meat and veggies on top. Return pie to oven and finish baking for 10-15 minutes or until the potato mix layer is hot and the edge of the crust is lightly brown.
- 9. Serve hot and enjoy.

### **Rokeg Blood Pie**

(with real blood)

#### **Ingredients**

600ml / 20 fl oz pig's blood 150ml / 5 fl oz heavy cream 280g / 10oz pork back fat, finely diced 280g / 10oz onions, finely diced 2 tablespoons rolled oats 1 tablespoon salt ½ tablespoon smoked paprika ½ tablespoon sweet paprika ½ tablespoon nutmeg ½ tablespoon white pepper ½ tablespoon chili flakes (optional) 3 small beetroots with long roots (if preparing the pie to look like it does on The Next Generation) For the pastry (If using): 180g / 6 1/3oz butter, at room temperature 240g / 81/2oz flour 1-2 tablespoons ice water

#### **Directions**

- ♥ Preheat the oven to 180°C / 350°F.
- ♥ Start by making the pastry (if using). Rub the flour and butter together in a bowl until the mixture resembles breadcrumbs. Add a tablespoon of ice water and bring the mixture together into a ball. Add the second tablespoon of water if needed. Wrap the dough in plastic wrap and refrigerate until needed.

#### For the filling:

- ♥ Start by cooking the onions until soft, and then add the diced pork fat. Cook for a few minutes until the fat turns slightly translucent, then remove from the heat and let cool.
- ♥ Put the blood in a blender and blend for a couple of minutes to break it up, then strain into a bowl, to remove any clots. To the blood, add the cooled pieces of fat and onions, cream and the oats and spices. Stir well to combine.
- ♥ Roll out the pastry and place onto a tart or pie pan. Cover with aluminum foil and add pie weights, coins or dried beans as weights. Bake for about 15 minutes, until it begins to brown.

- ♥ Remove the foil and the weights, and immediately add the blood mixture. Make sure you stir it, so any bits that have fallen to the bottom are remixed. I find it easiest to use a soup ladle and ladle it in to the pie shell.
- ▶ Bake for about 30-40 minutes, or until the mixture is firm to the touch and a dark bown colour. If desired, add any scraps of pastry to the top in a lattice or other design. Return to the oven and bake for a further 5 minutes to brown the pastry.

**Note:** If you want to make the version as it appeared on TNG, boil your beetroots for about 20 minutes, so they are starting to soften but not completely soft. Make the filling as described above, then pour into a glass bowl. Insert the beetroots in the top, and bake for 30-40 minutes until the mixture is firm to the touch. Serve to your Klingon High Council and be assured that honour is satisfied.


