

REPLIMAT RECIPES

Mother's Day is coming up this month, and sometimes it's hard to find that perfect gift. So why not bake a cake from scratch to show the mom in your life how much you care? (Just make sure to also clean up after yourself in the kitchen. That might be the biggest gift right there.)

But what cake should you make? Counselor Deanna Troi is a Star Trek mom who sometimes gets overlooked due to the very unusual circumstances of her pregnancy ("*The Child*" TNG Season 2). Perhaps the Counselor needed some counseling of her own after that. Hopefully she did not take Data's approach and consult the holodeck's Sigmund Freude program. Which leads us to this Star Trek cake option for Mother's Day. The Counselor Troi-shaped Cellular Peptide Cake with Mint Frosting, as seen in Season 7 episode "*Phantasms*."

Cellular Peptide Cake with Mint Frosting

Ingredients:

For the Cake:

- 2 3/4 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 2/3 cups granulated sugar
- 1 tablespoon baking powder
- 3/4 teaspoon salt
- 3/4 cup unsalted butter, softened
- 4 egg whites
- 1 whole egg
- 1 cup vanilla yogurt
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 1 teaspoon almond extract (optional)

For the Frosting:

- 1 1/2 cups powdered sugar
- 2 tablespoons milk
- 1 tablespoon butter or shortening
- 1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract
- A few drops of mint extract (or to taste)
- Blue food coloring
- Black food coloring (or methods to create black frosting)

Directions:

Baking the Cake:

- 1. Preheat your oven to 350°F.
- 2. In a large mixing bowl, cream the softened butter and granulated sugar together until light and fluffy.
- 3. Add the egg whites one at a time, beating well after each addition, then add the whole egg and mix until fully combined.
- 4. In a separate bowl, whisk together the flour, baking powder, and salt.
- 5. Gradually add the dry ingredients to the butter mixture, mixing until just combined.

- 6. In another bowl, whisk together the yogurt, vanilla extract, and almond extract (if using).
- 7. Add the yogurt mixture to the batter and beat until the batter is smooth and fluffy.
- 8. Pour the batter into a small square baking pan and spread it out evenly.
- 9. Bake for 30-40 minutes, or until a toothpick inserted into the center comes out clean.
- 10.Let the cake cool completely.



Making the Frosting and Decorating:

- 1. In a small bowl, combine the powdered sugar, milk, shortening, vanilla extract, and mint extract (if using). Beat until smooth and creamy. If the frosting is too thin, add more powdered sugar to thicken. If too thick, add a bit more milk.
- 2. Split the frosting into two bowls. Stir the blue food coloring to one bowl, using enough to achieve a deep blue color. Add the black food coloring to the other bowl, stirring until uniform in color.
- 3. Once the cake has cooled, cut it into a T or torso shape by trimming the sides to create the desired silhouette.
- 4. Frost the cake with the blue frosting for the body and black frosting for the details, emulating the TNG uniform (see above image). Add a Starfleet com badge, either in yellow icing or a real one (if you have one), and you've got a cake that'll make any mother's day.
